We appreciate deeply your generous contributions whether it be through the plate at Sunday Masses, the Envelope Collection, Standing Orders or the shrines.

We have a variety of ways that you can contribute to the Parish:

Weekly Envelopes: You can contact the Parish Office to request a new Envelope Box. **Standing Orders:** You can set up a regular S/O with your bank for monthly, quarterly or annual payments. Income Tax Rebate scheme:

A total annual contribution by you of €250 or more can allow the Parish to benefit from an Income Tax Rebate.

Examples of Income Tax Rebate for Dunshaughlin and Culmullen Parish

Your annual	Revenue rebate to	Total value of your
donation	Parish	donation
€250	€112.32	€362.32
€500	€224.64	€724.64
€750	€336.96	€1086.96
€1000	€449.27	€1449.27

Payments made by way of Standing Order, Envelope collection or by Cheque will qualify for the scheme. The Tax Rebate scheme provides a valuable source of income for the Parish and one that we would hope to increase.

For the Parish to benefit from an Income Tax Rebate on your contribution, the Parishioner must return a completed form to the Parish and must have paid the equivalent amount or more of the rebate in income Tax in that calendar year. The forms (CHY3 or CHY4) can be obtained from the Parish Office or downloaded online.
