## St Oliver Plunkett

Each year on the First Sunday of July, Ceremonies take place at Loughcrew, Oldcastle, the birthplace of St Oliver Plunkett. This year, however the Mass is postponed due to Government restrictions. St Oliver Plunkett was born in 1625 in Oldcastle, his family were part of the Irish Nobility with links to Killeen and Dunsany Castles. He was educated in Rome and taught theology there for many years. The second half of the seventeenth century was a difficult time for Catholics particularly in Ireland. Oliver was appointed Archbishop of Armagh and arrived in Ireland in 1669 to take up his ministry. He worked hard in very difficult circumstances most of the time he travelled in disguise. It is said he administered the Sacrament of Confirmation to 48,000 Catholic over a four year period. Oliver was falsely accused of being involved in what was called the 'Popish Plot' to bring French troops into Ireland to overthrow the English. Without the benefit of defence he was found guilty of high treason and sentenced to death. He was executed in London in 1681. He was the first of the Irish Martyrs to be beatified in 1920 and was canonised by Pope Paul VI in 1975. He is buried at Downside Abbey in England, his head is venerated in St. Peter's in Drogheda.
