Eucharistic Adoration

Jesus pleads with us to watch one hour with Him. Mt 26:40.

Eucharistic Adoration is the veneration and worship given to Jesus in the exposed Blessed Sacrament. During times specifically reserved for Eucharistic Adoration, the consecrated Host is put on public display in a monstrance on the Altar.

People attend for designated hours to adore, make reparation and to worship Our Divine Lord truly present in the Blessed Sacrament.

We are talking of ‘an hour of companionship with the Lord’.

When you commit to a weekly hour of adoration you are responding to the call Jesus made in the garden of Gethsemane “Could you not watch one hour with me”? By giving honour and glory to God in Eucharistic Adoration you are touching the heart of the Church and her salvific mission expressed in the Lord’s Prayer! ‘Hallowed be thy name, Thy Kingdom come on earth; thy will be done...



Eucharistic Adoration will continue for July and August as follows:

Dunshaughlin: Church Tuesdays 10:30am until 2 pm; 7pm until 9 pm

Culmullen: Thursdays 9:30am until 11 am

If you can pledge even one hour during these times please contact the Parish Office.

We also encourage people to come and spend some time adoration when you can.

We are hoping to establish a new Adoration Team in the Parish with a view to re-launch Adoration in September as we hopefully resume normal post Covid schedules. Adoration is about sitting in the presence of the Lord, meditation and perseverance.
