## Ash Wednesday beginning of Lenten Season Masses on Webcam only 10.00 am and 7.00 pm

Next Wednesday the 17<sup>th</sup> February Lent begins with the blessing and distribution of ashes. Ashes will be blessed and will be throughout the day in the Churches for people to come and collect.

Please bring your own little container or envelope if you wish to take some to other family members, neighbours or housebound people.

The Congregation in Rome recommends that in the interest of health and safety, that ashes be sprinkled on the head rather than a mark is placed on the forehead.

So when you come to the Church, take a pinch of ashes and sprinkle on your head before entering the Church and spending some time in prayer, we recommend the Our Father, the Hail Mary and Glory be to the Father Son and Holy Spirit.

It is also recommended to read the Gospel of the day, the lectionary will be open in front of the Altar.
