Grandparents Day

This year Pope Francis has designated the Sunday nearest to the Feast Day as Grandparents Day. We pray for all grandparents and acknowledge the valuable role they play in handing on the faith to their grandchildren.

Special Prayers will be said at our Masses and on webcam on Sunday, 25th of July.

First Communion

We ask parents to continue to pray with their children who are waiting for the Sacrament of Holy Communion. We begin by carefully making the sign of the cross, reminding them to bless themselves;

In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit

Always begin to pray with the sign of the Cross, say the Morning Prayer, the Hail Mary and Our Father.

In the evening, say the Act of Sorrow which they learned for their First Confession;
Oh my God, thank you for loving me, I am sorry for all my sins for not loving others and not loving you, help me to live like Jesus and not sin again. Amen.

We suggest joining us for Sunday Mass, if not in Church then on our Webcam at 12 noon. We recommend a visit to the Church, spending a little quiet time in prayer before the Tabernacle. Also visit our children's corner for child friendly resources and also take home our Mass Missalette.
