Lent is the time for letting go, the readings today make that point very well. If we are to come to know God and the meaning of real love, then we must learn to let go of our certainties and insisting on having things our way. Abraham and Jesus both learned to entrust everything into the hands of God the Father, even when this appeared to lead to the end of everything they had hoped for. God in Jesus would have us understand that He is with us in every moment of our lives and each moment whether at the top of the mountain or in Gethsemane is sacred. If we are to understand this we must develop the art of doing what the Father has asked us and that is the art of listening, really listening to His Son.
