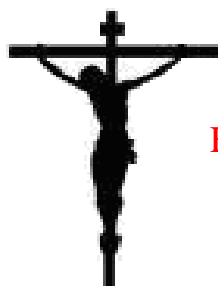
First Communion

We are preparing a new website for the Parish of Dunshaughlin and Culmullen. It is hoped that the website will be launched early September. The website will be a window on the Parish and will have information on all aspects of parish life. It will incorporate the webcam which facilitates live streaming of Masses. The Website will be useful for information about Masses, Confessions, Weddings, Baptisms and Funerals. There will also be a youth section and details on Faith Formation Courses in the Parish.

St Seachnall's Cemetery

We are planning to have the roadside wall painted in September. The Cross at the Centre of the Graveyard is in need of attention it is planned to have it repaired and painted as well.

Return to Mass

We have five Mass on weekends as follows; Vigils; Saturday Culmullen 6 pm and Dunshaughlin at 7 pm. On Sunday 9am and 12 noon in Dunshaughlin and 10:30am in Culmullen. The Masses in Dunshaughlin Church can take over 100 people in compliance with present restrictions; Culmullen Church can take over 50 people. We welcome people back to Mass, there is room particularly in Culmullen and the 7 pm Vigil in Dunshaughlin. Some people have mentioned the fact that they don't feel safe returning to Mass just yet. This is understandable and is quite acceptable, however we can re assure people that our Churches are safe, people wear masks at all times, sanitizing procedures are adhered to and social distancing is strictly maintained. Accordingly we are happy to invite people to return to Mass.

We also have weekday Masses, attendance in Dunshaughlin is around 40 to 50 Culmullen is 20 to 30. Dunshaughlin can take 100. For parishioners who don't feel like returning to Sunday Masses we suggest maybe coming one day a week to the 10am Mass, there is an opportunity to attend Mass in person and also receive the Lord in Holy Communion. Meanwhile Masses will continue to be streamed on our parish webcam Failte roimh chach.
