1st February Feast St Brigid's Day.

St Brigid along with Patrick is Patron of Ireland.

She was born in 454 AD. Despite coming from a well off family she opted for religious life and dedicated herself to God and the poor. She is renowned for her kindness, hospitality and care of the sick. She built her convent in Kildare and is honoured there to this day. As Patrick used the shamrock Brigid used the Cross made from reeds to explain the Christian faith.
