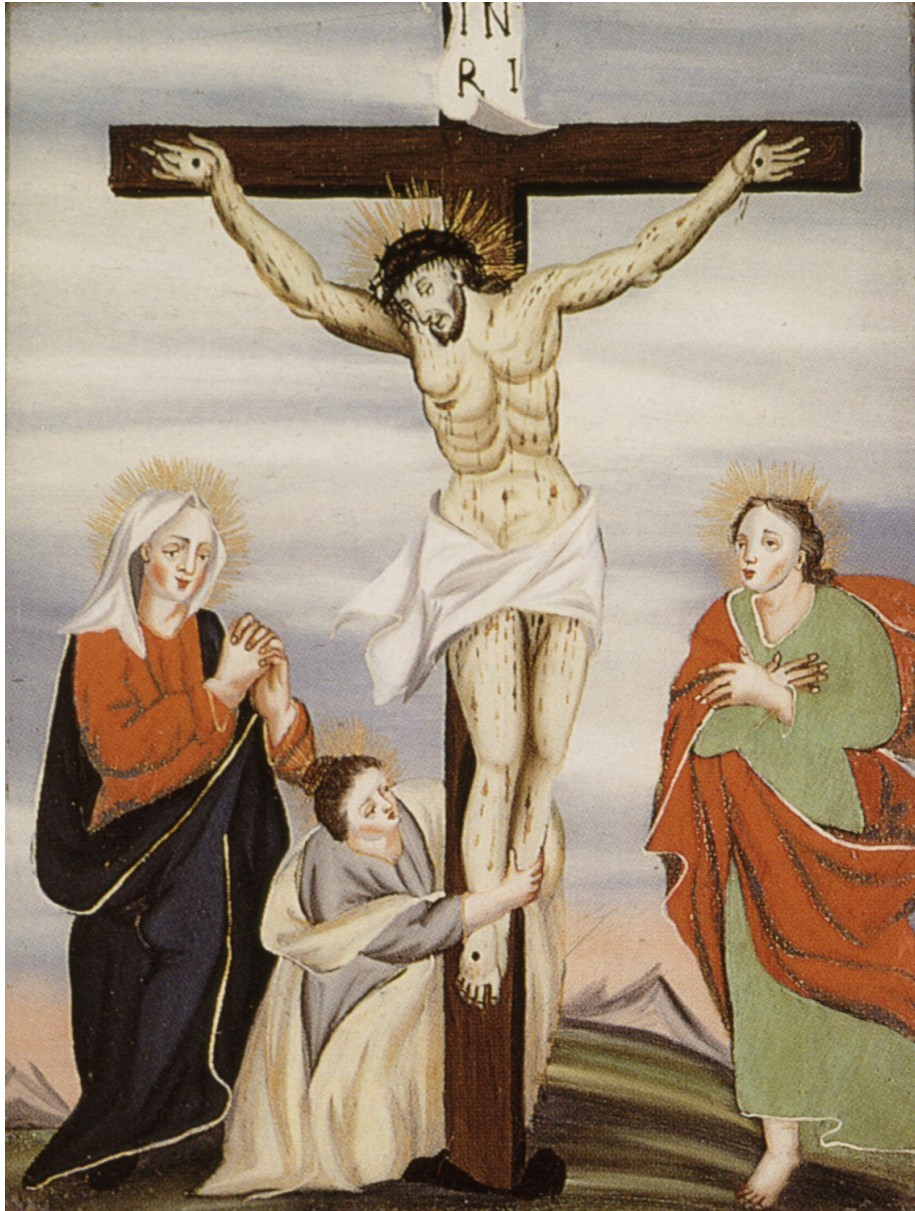

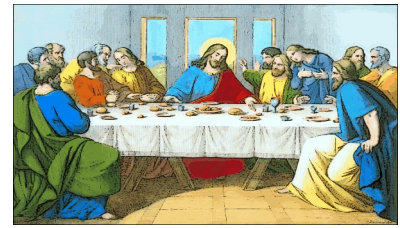
Holy Week
