Baptismal Font

The Baptismal Font has been restored, polished and installed in the Parish Church. The new position allows parents and godparents to gather around the font for the Sacrament.

Dunshaughlin has experienced rapid growth in recent years and the number of baptisms continues to increase, we welcome the children

and their parents. For example 7 babies were baptised in the Parish this weekend.

The Limestone Font you see, is the original Font carved from stone quarried in Ardraccan, over 150 years ago and placed in the Old Church, now the Library.

In 1982, the Font was transferred to the New Church.

The plinth on which the Font rests is new; it too is local limestone from a quarry in Meath. The Font reminds us of our Baptism and commitment to Christian life.
