## Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

The theme of our Liturgy today is Prayer, Jesus taught his disciples to pray.

Jesus is seen praying often to his Father in Heaven, he encouraged his followers to pray.

Prayer is central to the mission of the Church.

Every Tuesday we have adoration in Dunshaughlin Church as follows;

10:30am until pm and 7pm until 9pm. Thursday 9.30am until 11am in Culmullen Church

We invite parishioners to come and spend one hour or even less in prayer.

No need to sign up or give notice, simply come along.

An hour with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament can be structured like this;

**Adoration** - 15 minutes sitting quietly in His presence, do, say nothing just sit.

**Thanksgiving** - Praise the Lord, thank God for all his gifts to you and others

**Reparation** - Acknowledge faults, express sorry and ask his mercy for our sins and the sins of the whole world.

**Petition** - Ask for deepening of your faith, also for personal needs & those of your family and friends.

Pray for the world for peace and an end to war especially in Ukraine, pray for the Church, for renewal of faith, and for young people.
