Dunshaughlin Church - Heating Project

For some time the Parish Finance Committee have been working on plans to upgrade the heating in Dunshaughlin Church. Basically the gas heaters installed 40 years ago have performed well but are now reaching the end of their useful lives.

One of the heaters is out of order, now disconnected, another is not working efficiently. We have been informed that repairing the heaters is not an option.

Furthermore to replace them with similar appliances would require putting extractors into the roof to comply with current regulations for the use of such heaters.

This would prove very costly, unsightly and possibly harm the roof.

After much discussion and research, the Finance Committee have decided to install a conventional radiator system in the Sanctuary area and front part of the Church as an initial phase towards upgrading the heating system. Costs are high at present and getting higher. We are advised that the total cost of this phase could be over 50 thousand euro.

The Committee have received the approval of the Diocesan Commission to carry out these works and it is hoped the project can start in the next month or so and be completed before the winter. Full details will be given in due course. There may be some disruption for a week or two, for example daily Mass in Dunshaughlin Church may need to move to the Pastoral Centre to avoid disrupting the builders.

Withering Trees

It is noticed that many of the trees in the church grounds and around the Pastoral Centre are dying prematurely from the top downwards. If anyone with knowledge in this area can offer us some advice, please contact the Parish Office.

Fire doors - Culmullen Hall

The Finance Committee have arranged to install new fire doors in Culmullen Hall.

This is necessary to comply with HSE regulations, particularly in relation to the presence of the pre-school in the building.

Pastoral Centre

Ongoing maintenance is a very important part of our program in the parish.

Re-decorating of the Pastoral Centre will commence this week.

The painting project will take a couple of weeks. We apologise for any disruption.
