Willie Doyle was born in Dublin, in 1873 and entered the Jesuits in Rahan, in 1891. He served as chaplain in Irish Division of the British Army. He was heroic in tending the wounded on the battlefield many Catholic but not all. He is revered throughout the world for his strong faith, his heroism and courage.
