

### Baptism of the Lord.

Jesus is baptised in the River Jordan by John the Baptist, He is anointed with the Spirit and his power. He is proclaimed Messiah. Jesus now goes about doing good, working the miracles that make him known as the Servant of God. He is the one that brings good news to the poor and tells of salvation

Through our baptism each one of us is ordered to the life of Christ. — Priest, Prophet and King and the Father looks on all of us with favour.

Today we renew our baptismal promises and we are blessed with water as a reminder of our baptism.

We pray for all who have been baptised in our Parish over the course of the year, 133 children have been baptised in Dunshaughlin `& Culmullen churches.

We encourage their parents and god parents to hand on the faith according to the promises they made on the day they presented their child for christening.
