St Brigid - Naomh Bríd

St Brigid's Cross One of the most widespread Irish customs associated with Saint Brigid is the making of the CROS BRIDE — St. Brigid's Cross The story is told of the pagan chieftain tin was converted to Christianity On his deathbed. Brigid was visiting him one day, she sat in silence beside the dying man's bed. She took a few rushes from the floor & began to weave a Cross. He watched attentively and then, asked her what she was doing. She explained in detail that the **Cross of Christ is the symbol of our salvation. The dying man questioned her and she told him how Jesus is God made Flesh and He died on the CROSS to buy us back from the power of the devil and hell and that he came on earth to save all people, including him.** The Chieftain listened carefully overcome with the idea that he could be loved so much and before he died he became a Christian and was baptised. "God loved the world so much that he gave us His only Son to redeem and save us and set us free. (John 3:16.)
