Planning a wedding in Dunshaughlin and Culmullen Parish.

Three months notice must be given to Civil Registrar of Marriages.

The Wedding must be booked well in advance with the Parish Secretary. Couples should speak directly with Priest/Celebrant of their choice.

The following papers are required by all couples

Baptismal Certificate issued within six months of wedding and confirmation cert.

Letter of freedom, this can take the form of a letter from parents certifying their son/daughter has not been previously married in a religious or civil ceremony. It can also take the form of a civil affidavit signed in the presence of a Commissioner for Oaths.

Sample forms available at Parish Office

Pre nuptial enquiry forms completed by the priest where each party resides at present.

The pre-nuptial enquiry form should be completed well in advance of the wedding and should be received at Parish Office at least one month prior to the wedding.
