We have Rosary Beads, medals, pictures, cards and books. We also stock Confirmation Cards and Rosettes for the boys and medals for the girls.



Lent - Time to Pause

Lent is a time to act and a time to pause, to pause in prayer, in order to receive the word of God, to pause like the Samaritan



in the presence of a wounded brother or sister. Love of God and love of neighbour are one love. Not to have other Gods is to pause in the presence of God beside the flesh of our Neighbour. For this reason prayer, fasting and almsgiving are not three unrelated acts but a single movement of openness and self-emptying in which we cast out the idols that weigh us down, slow down then and pause, the contemplative dimension of life that Lent helps us re discover will release new energies. In the presence of God we become more sensitive to one another; we discover companions and fellow travellers.
