Annual Financial Statement

We present today in summary form our statement of income and expenditure for 2023. We thank all who contributed so generously throughout the year. Our income remains steady while expenditure increases. We carried out major repairs to the heating system and to the roof in the Pastoral Centre at a cost of approx twenty thousand euro. Looking ahead it is hoped to have the outside of Dunshaughlin Church repainted this summer as well as the perimeter walls of the Church grounds. We hope to initiate a plan for restoration work to Culmullen Church.

It is planned to install barriers at the entrance to the Church car park so that the car park can be closed at night for security reasons.

Our thanks to the Parish Finance Committee, to our Collectors in both Churches to our dedicated counting and lodgement teams and to all who contribute so generously and consistently by whatever means throughout the year. Mile buiochas
