Safeguarding Children Policy Statement for the Diocese of Meath

The Gospel teaches the importance of ensuring that the church community is a warm, welcoming & safe place for children. 'Let the little children come to me, & do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. Truly I tell you, anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it'Mark10:14-15

Children are gifts from God, to be cherished and recognised for the joyful contribution they bring as valued members of the Church. Our challenge is to follow the example of Jesus in cherishing children. Safeguarding is key to this important task and should be seen not as a burden but as an opportunity to embrace and encourage children's ministry, following the example of Christ.

The Diocese of Meath pledges to safeguard children from harm and to support them in their development as valued and integral members of the Catholic Church in Ireland.

The Church's ministry will be inclusive and will uphold the rights of children. Consistent with Gospel values, and with civil and criminal law, those who minister will do so with dignity and integrity, honouring their calling to ensure that children are welcomed, cherished and protected, following the example set by Jesus.
