Canonisations - Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio

This Sunday Pope Leo will canonise Carlo Acutis and Pier Georgio, ie, they will be enrolled among the Saints in Heaven.

Carlo Acutis lived in this century; he died at the age of 15.

He is known as 'God's influencer' for creating a website dedicated to Eucharistic Miracles and for using his computer skills to spread the faith.

Pier Giorgio lived in the early part of the twentieth Century he grew up in Turin.

Pier who died at the age of 24 is celebrated for his profound charity, passionate faith and love of sport, he like Carlo is an inspiration to youth and a modern role model of holiness. Miracles have been attributed to the intercession of both saints.

Culmullen Church — update

The exterior of the Church has been cleaned of dirt, moss and grime.

This work was carried out by a reputable and approved Company, the cost was just under €10,000. 'The 150 Committee' and Architect have prioritised repairs to the roof of the Church and the turret. Temporary repairs with expandable foam were carried out recently, ingress of water has stopped, this may change according to prevailing winds It is hoped this work will be carried out May to July 2026.

The Committee have made application for grant aid to the 'Built Heritage Investment Scheme'. It is hoped this will succeed to help with the cost of the project. Meanwhile we ask parishioners to use weekly envelopes or standing orders to make a contribution to the funds — every little helps.
