Parishes have been assigned an hour in the Cathedral. Please note Dunshaughlin/Culmullen Parish are invited to be present for Adoration on Saturday 22^{nd} November from 3 pm until 4 pm.

There will be confessions from noon on Sat until midnight in the Cathedral.
