The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ 'Corpus Christi'

The Feast of Corpus Christi originated in the 13th Century in Belgium.

It was established as a universal Feast by Pope Urban IV to emphasise the joy and mystery of the Holy Eucharist. It was proposed by St Thomas Aquinas, Doctor of the Church, in order to create a Feast solely focused on the Blessed Eucharist.

'Corpus Christi, shows ever greater homage to Christ, to thank him for so great a gift and to implore His mercy'. Pope St Paul VI. Many devotions spring from Corpus Christi, Eucharistic Adoration, Corpus Christi Procession, and beautiful hymns such as 'Pange Lingua' and 'Panis Angelicus'.

A short Procession of the Blessed Eucharist will take place after the 12 noon Mass today.
