Magnificat Humanitas – Pope Leo XIV

Chapter One A Dynamic Approach-Faithful to the Gospel'

Extract — Interpreting history in the light of faith.

It is clear the Church's Social Doctrine is not the result of a project devised at a desk, but rather the product of a patient process in which each pontiff — together with the Second Vatican Council - made a unique contribution on the light of 'new things' of each particular era. In response to the challenges of their time each one interpreted historical changes according to the Gospel, bringing to light different aspects of a single heritage; the dignity of the person, the value of work, the universal destination of goods, solidarity and subsidiary, care for creation and the centrality of peace and fraternity.

It is to the great principles of Social Doctrine, which direct the discernment of believers in their personal and public lives that I now wish to turn our attention, in order to grasp more effectively their internal coherence and capacity to guide our times.
